



CFL contribution takes St. Jude's Fund to over \$1,000,000

Consolidated Foods Limited (operators of Super J Supermarkets and Mega J) has assured the government of its commitment to being part of the restoration of St. Jude's hospital. The assurance was given by Chairman of CFL's Board, Michael Chastanet, as he presented a cheque of one hundred thousand (\$100,000) to Prime Minister Stephenson King towards the rebuilding effort.



The presentation was made at the Prime Minister's Office on Friday September 25, in the presence of St. Jude's Hospital Administrator Andrina Henry as well as some of CFL's Management team. In presenting the cheque, Mr. Chastanet emphasized that CFL has a proud tradition of responding to the needs of the community – in both good and bad times.

“As an indigenous operator, this philosophy is guided by our mission to be socially conscious, ethically responsible and contribute towards the economic development of the country” he noted.

Prime Minister Stephenson King and the Administrator of St. Jude's both expressed their gratitude to CFL for the company's commitment to both the short term recovery effort at the stadium and the long term rebuilding process. The Prime Minister noted that based on cheques presented to his office to date, CFL's one hundred thousand contribution, takes the St. Jude's Fund to over one million dollars.
