More Funds for Haiti - CFL responds

More funds continue to pour in for Haiti following the catastrophic January 12 earthquake that rocked the country. In response to the Saint Lucia Chamber of Commerce's rallying call for local business houses to support the Haiti Relief Effort, Consolidated Foods Limited (CFL) has committed \$15,000 to the relief efforts. The cheque was presented to the St. Lucia Red Cross last Friday at a presentation facilitated by the Executive Director of the Chamber, Brian Louisy.



Mr. Louisy acknowledged and commended CFL for its generous contribution. While noting that many Chamber members have already heeded the call to donate, he encouraged the membership to continue to assist in whatever way possible. The Chamber Director said the need for assistance has become even more critical, as heavy rains have now added urgency to the Haitian government's appeal for assistance.

One month after the magnitude seven earthquake shattered Haiti, the impoverished country is now grappling with rain-triggered landslides and there is an intensified relief campaign to house the homeless, estimated at more than one million.
